Meet

Saturday, May 5 @ 8:00AM, Leaving at 9:00AM East Lake Lowe's (2225 Otay Lakes Road, Chula Vista, CA) Chevron Gas Station and Krispy Kreme in the mall.



Turn right onto Otay Lakes Rd
Take the 1st left onto Otay Lakes Rd / 10.7 miles
Turn right onto CA-94 E/Campo Rd / 26.3 miles
Final Destination is 31471 CA Highway 94
Chevron Gas Station and Subway

Lunch on the Way Back

Head South on CA-94 W/Campo Rd toward Forest Gate Road / 16.7 miles
Turn right on Barrett Lake Rd
Final Destination is Barrett Junction Cafe (1020 Barrett Lake Rd)

End Where We Began

Head Southwest on Barrett Lake Rd toward CA-94 E/Campo Rd
Turn right onto CA-94 W/Campo Rd / 9.6 miles
Turn left onto Otay Lakes Rd / 10.7 miles
Turn right, then left and arrive at East Lake Lowe's (2225 Otay Lakes Rd)

Guidelines – most of this is common sense but it doesn't hurt to remind everyone:

- Make sure you have a full tank of gas before we head out!
- If possible, try to take up both lanes on a red light so we all get across on one green light
- No overtaking in the group, stay behind the leader/tour guide who knows the route
- Someone will be dedicated to bring up the rear. This person should know the route as well in case the group gets separated in order to lead the rest to the destination. The leader will also look out for this person in the rearview mirror to make sure the group is complete.
- You are responsible for the person behind you. If you notice he or she is falling behind or has any type of emergency, slow down or stop and get the attention of the one in front of you by flashing the high beams and/or honking. The group slows down or stops at the next possibility until everyone has caught up. This does not apply during canyon carving, although both the "fast" and "slow" group should have dedicated leaders and "rear guards".
- Use caution when passing other motorists! You alone are responsible for a safe overtaking maneuver. Don't get pulled along with the rest of the group and flash your lights in order for the group to slow down a bit when you are stuck behind someone.
- Along the way there are certain areas that are camp grounds and/or little communities that we want to slow down at because of kids and people being around.
- Don't speed up when other vehicles pass you! This might trap them and endanger the group or oncoming traffic.
- Along the way there is a guy that takes pictures of all cars and bikes cruising the road. He catches
 cars coming out of a nice turn and usually snaps a couple of picks and puts them on his website for
